

## ClearShield Durable Glass Surface Protection Limited Warranty Guidelines\* Shower Glass

### 1. General

- a) ClearShield provides durable glass surface protection with “non-stick”, easy-clean, low-maintenance, stain-resistant performance.
- b) All claims and warranties for ClearShield are based on actual experience for almost 30 years on shower glass and all types of buildings, marine vessels and transportation vehicles. Real life experience under actual conditions of exposure and use, not laboratory tests or water repellency, is the only basis for predicting performance or durability.
- c) ClearShield is manufactured to exacting specifications under a strict quality assurance program meeting the requirements of ISO 9001.

### 2. Limited Warranty – to end users

Provided the glass is maintained according to published after-care instructions and without the use of abrasive cleaning methods or highly alkaline products, CST warrants that ClearShield will for up to ten (10) years from the date of application make glass installed in showers –

- much easier to clean and keep clean compared with untreated glass;
- resistant to glass surface corrosion, staining and discoloration.

In addition, CST warrants that ClearShield will not for the lifetime of the glass crack, peel or flake.

This Limited Warranty also requires that:

- application of ClearShield is applied only by person(s) trained and certified by CST, or an authorized representative, and according to CST's standard application instructions;
- end user registers with CST within sixty (60) days of shower door installation at the original residence.

ClearShield can be easily and safely re-applied on shower doors already installed. If the conditions described above are met, subject to limitations, and ClearShield fails to perform as stated above, CST will provide to the end user at no extra charge sufficient ClearShield product for re-application. Labor and incidental costs are excluded.
